Trophies

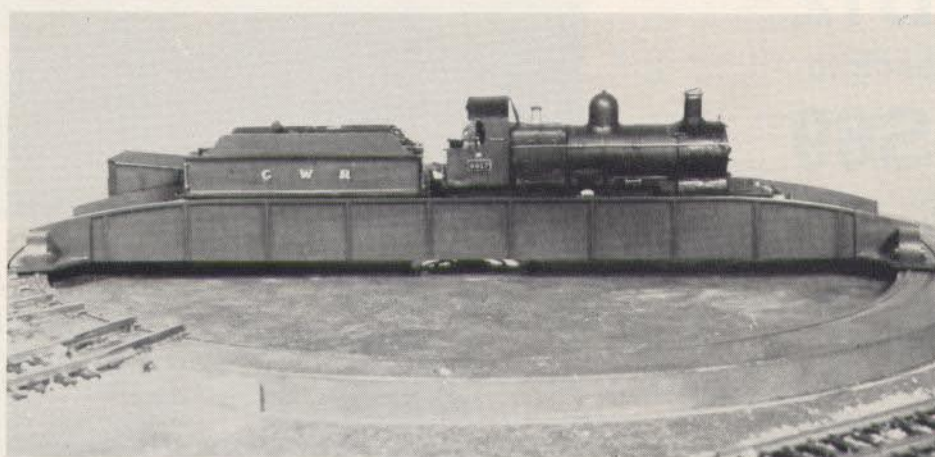
Static models in all of the popular scales up to and including 7mm will be shown and there will also be various scenic set pieces in various scales. For the show, the Club are running

competitions for their five trophies and all the entries for these will be on show. The Committee Cup will be presented for the best scenic set piece in any scale in an area not exceeding 2 sq ft and the Churchward Trophy for the best model of any steam locomotive in any scale which has, at any time, run on lines in the British Isles. The other three trophies are for the best models of complete trains, the Rake Trophy being for the best in any scale and then the winners of the Smyth Cup and the Three Mille Cup will be chosen from the remaining entries in 4mm and 3mm

scales respectively.

There will be a well-stocked bookstall and refreshments will be available at moderate prices. There will also be a display of railway slides and, if it is completed in time, a cine film depicting club activities will be shown at regular intervals. All in all, therefore, there should be something to interest all modellers whatever their age or interest.

- 1 GW "Dukedog" 4-4-0 No. 9017 is being turned on the main loco depot turntable, a modified Tri-ang model. The locomotive was converted from an Airfix "City of Truro" kit as described in our August '64 issue.
- 2 A GW 5700 class 0-6-0PT shunts a freight into the junction yard as a Tri-ang SR electric unit sets off down the branch. As yet, however, no conductor rail has appeared on the layout!
